On November 28, 2022, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine announced that 708 schools in 57 counties received grants to pay for security upgrades that enhance the safety and security of students and staff. The grants are part of his \$100 million Ohio K-12 School Safety Grant Program. Round 3 was a competitive grant opportunity that attracted applications from more than 2,000 schools.

Ironton City Schools is pleased to announce that we have been awarded \$300,000 as part of this initiative. Funds can be used to cover expenses associated with physical security enhancements such as security cameras, public address systems, automatic door locks, visitor badging systems, and exterior lighting.
