

AIR Assessment

State Testing & Graduation Requirements

Beginning with the class of 2018, students are now required to take seven end-of-course state assessments throughout their high school career. In order to be eligible for graduation, students must earn a cumulative passing score of 18 points. To ensure that all students are well rounded, students must also earn a minimum of four points in math, four points in English, and six points between science/social studies. Scores will be reported in a 1-5 scale (1 Limited, 2 Basic, 3 Proficient, 4 Accelerated, 5 Advanced). If a student scores limited or basic on any of the tested areas, they will have the opportunity to retest once they have received intervention, offered during elective courses at Ironton High School.
