**IMPORTANT NOTE: Students should check their email frequently, as this is the preferred method of communication between teachers and students.**

## **HOW DO STUDENTS LOG IN?**

Most students should be familiar with our online learning platform—GoogleClassroom. Students can access Classroom by signing-in to Google using their Ironton username (this is their tigertown.com email). From there students can access learning materials, class assignments, and the teacher’s GoogleMeet link.

Their GoogleMeet link is the interface through which teachers will provide live lessons and be available to assist students.

## **WHEN DO STUDENTS LOG IN TO THEIR GoogleMeet?**

Students will follow their daily class schedule to log in to GoogleMeets.

## **WHAT IF STUDENTS DO NOT ATTEND PRESCRIBED MEETINGS?**

The attendance policy remains the same whether students are virtual or in-person. Students must attend their GoogleMeets as scheduled, and on time. Chronic absenteeism will be addressed according to district and state policies.
